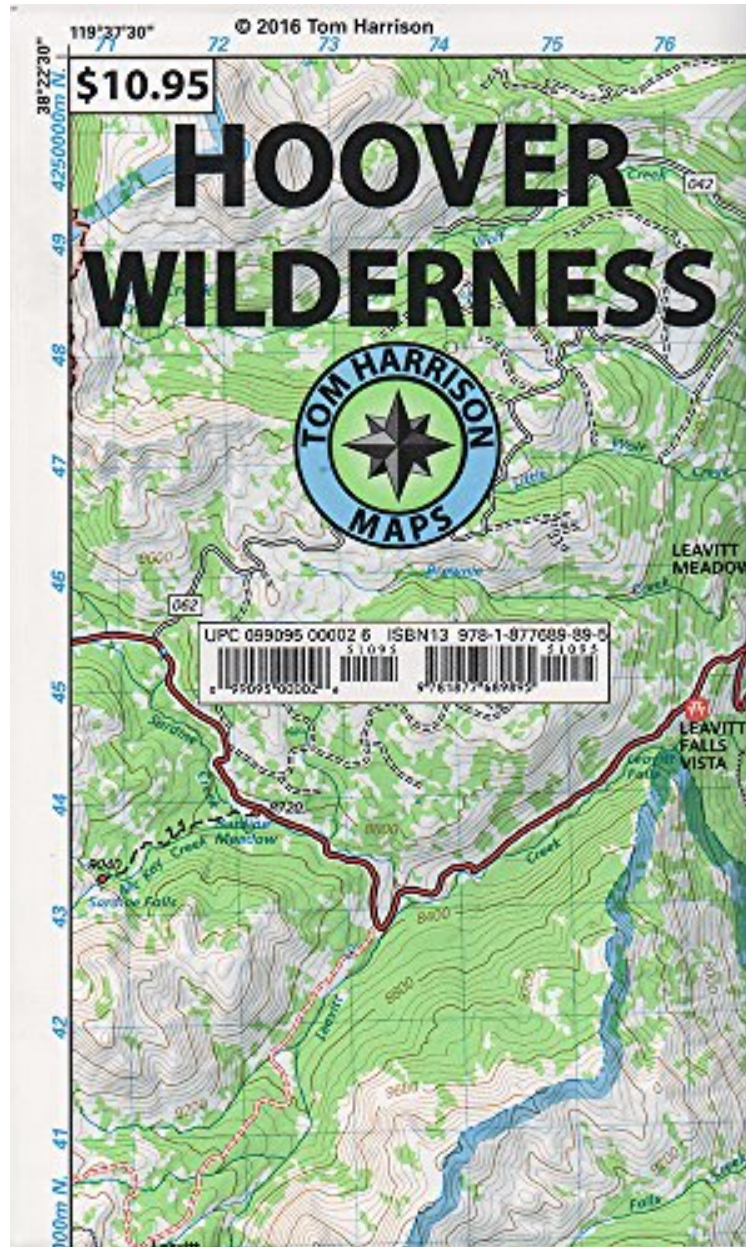

Great for trip planning...By GunnyThe Tom Harrison maps each cover a lot of area and are perfect for planning your backcountry trips. Because of the large areas they cover the detail isn't very close-up so definitely not good for backcountry route finding if doing anything above class 1. If needing a map to navigate by when going cross country then get a USGS map which won't cover as much area but has much better detail. They do work well in conjunction with my gps if I stay on trail though which reduces the # of maps I have to take with me and less is always a good thing when it comes to my backpack weight. It does have extra area on the east where most access roads come in from I 395 and Bridgeport.

Wheeler Flat Bush Mountain, Sweetwaters, and Huntoon Valley.If you are planning a trans-Sierra trip you will probably use this map while connecting the Trail to the Pacific Crest Trail on your way to the Emigrant Wilderness in the west side of the Sierras. Adjacent to this map; to the South is the Yosemite High Country Trail Map, to the West the Emigrant Wilderness Trail Map and to the East the Bodie Hill Map.NO BIKES.
